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The words that have same pronunciation but differ in meaning and spelling is called Homophones.




See - sea

Hair- part of the body. my sister has long hairs.




No - Know

I meet my friend near meat stall.**




Mail – Male

Weak means that something is not strong.




Week is a measurement of time, meaning seven days.

A rabbit is also called a hare.









All parts together equal a whole.




